- There is a locked dark green mail box on the step of the parish offices in Mooers Forks. Envelopes with donations to help us pay our bills during this time can be placed securely in this box. Please do not place them in the big black mail box on the Town Hall Road.
- Confessions have been arranged to be heard safely from the front porch of the rectory in Mooers Forks. There is a confessional screen with a kneeler on the porch facing Route 11. Please ring the doorbell and Fr. Adrian will come to the window, not the door, to hear your confession. He will be hearing confessions for Holy Week during Holy Week during the hours of: Monday through Friday 12PM to 1PM and 6PM to 7PM.
- Palms, blessed by Father during his Palm Sunday Mass, will be available for anyone to pick up on the back steps of the Church at St. Ann's and on the front porch steps of the rectory at Holy Angels. We will put out all that we have.
- Further news will be sent to you should any come from the Diocese concerning the celebration of Holy Week. Be safe and be healthy.
